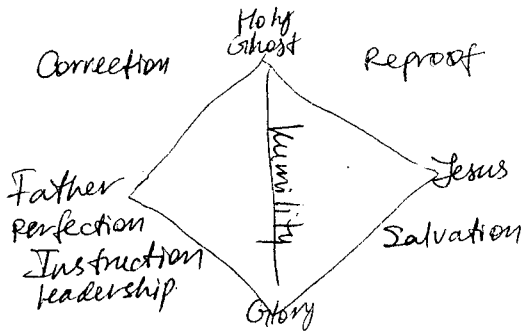

6. Must one join a church?

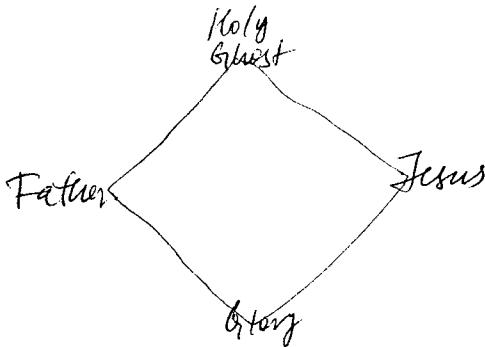
*Yes ~~yes~~. Church is the body of Christ, each one of us is a member of Ecclesia. (member of church)

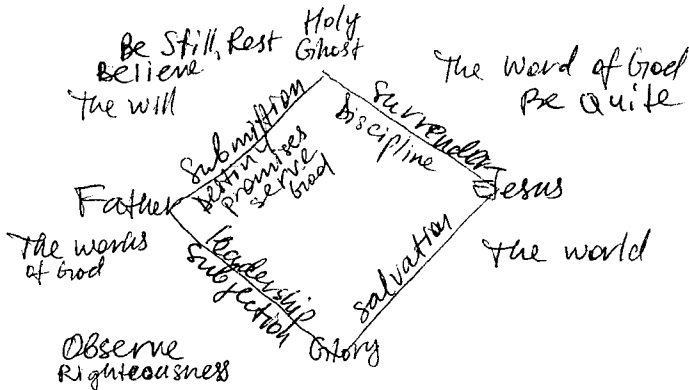
